2024 CONSTRUCTION LOOK AHEAD

FEBRUARY 2024

In 2024, work will focus on:

- I-69/I-465 system interchange opening to traffic
- Completion of aesthetics and landscaping in Johnson County
- Completion of Southport Road interchange area
- Completion of mainline I-69 pavement north of Southport Road
- I-465 and Harding Street interchange opening to traffic
- Installation of tree plantings and landscaping along I-69 in Marion County
- All new travel lanes on I-465 between I-70 and I-65
- I-465 westbound added travel lanes between I-70 and I-65
- I-465 westbound bridge over White River
- New roadway lighting installation along I-465
- Installation of noise barriers along I-69 and I-465
- I-69 designation from SR 144 to I-465

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2023 I-69 HIGHLIGHTS

- I-69 & I-465 system interchange construction began
- Steel girders set as beginning of I-69 northbound to I-465 westbound ramp
- All permanent ramps open at Southport Road interchange
- Last of 14 traffic signals removed at Fairview Road
- Smith Valley Road interchange open to traffic
- Celebration of work completed in Johnson County
- Aesthetic features added at SR 144 & Smith Valley Road
- Old SR 37 & SR 144 roundabout open to traffic







2023 I-465 HIGHLIGHTS

- Completion of mainline I-465 eastbound pavement
- 6 eastbound bridges completed over: White River, Harmond Ditch, Harding Street, Bluff Road, Indiana Rail Road, & Lick Creek
- I-465 westbound bridge over Meridian Street
- 20 drilled shafts at White River, roughly 110' deep
- Up to 7,000 workers along the corridor during peak construction activities
 New I-465/I-69 Interchange Construction
 - 500,000+ labor hours
 - 206,268 cubic yards of concrete placed
 - 23,419 tons of asphalt placed
